

Comic-journalism School

The Civic Integration Foundation (CIF) is a non-formal organization, committed to the promotion of civic integration in Georgia. The Organization focuses on supporting the integration of ethnic minorities – strengthening their civic and political participation in public and political life.



With the project Comic-Journalism school, the organization supported the development of media skills among current or future journalists and civic activists. They conducted trainings on using comics as a tool to report on social problems. Four two-day trainings were conducted at four locations: Marneuli, Kutaisi, Akhaltsikhe and Batumi.

After the trainings were conducted, a publication was developed and printed. It consists of seven stories on current social, ecological and economic problems.
